Thank you for your letter of 4th August about the Prime Minister's Audiences. I am afraid this does mean that there can be no Audience in the week beginning Monday 1st December.

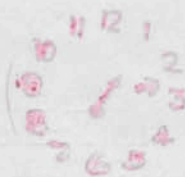
