DEAR NICANOR:

YOU WILL EAVE SEEN THE REMARKS I MADE TO THE PRESS ON LEAVING-LONDON, WHICH WERE MEANT TO BE RESPONSIVE TO THE CONCERN YOU RAISED WITH ME. IN TURN, LET ME STRESS WITH YOU, AS I DID WITH THE BRITISH LEADERS, HOW IMPORTANT IT IS THAT BOTH SIDES AVOID PUBLIC POSTURING OF THE SORT THAT COULD SPOIL THE PROSPECTS FOR GOOD-FAITH DISCUSSIONS.
