INTRODUCTION

MY FIRST WORDS MUST BE OF GRATITUDE TO THOSE WHO ORGANISED THIS CONFERENCE AND LOOKED AFTER OUR SECURITY, BRINGING US SAFELY TO THIS GREAT MASS MEETING.

THERE ARE MANY HERE TODAY WHO STILL BEAR THE SCARS OF INJURY AND BEREAVEMENT INFLICTED LAST YEAR BY TERRORISTS WHEN THEY STRUCK IN THE HOURS OF DARKNESS.

> THEY REMIND US OF THE RISKS WE ALL TAKE AND WILL CONTINUE TO TAKE FOR FREEDOM.

AND I SHOULD LIKE TO SAY A WORD ABOUT OUR FRIEND AND COLLEAGUE JOHN GUMMER WHOSE DEDICATION AND TIRELESSNESS IN THOSE TRAUMATIC HOURS AND FOR MANY DAYS AFTERWARDS WON UNIVERSAL ADMIRATION.

I REMEMBER THAT MEETING AS THOUGH IT WERE YESTERDAY.

THE WELCOME, THE WARMTH, THE GENEROUS SUPPORT THAT CAME UP FROM THE HALL. I ALREADY KNEW ONLY TOO WELL THE TASK THAT FACED ME.

BUT I HAD NOT FULLY REALISED THE STRENGTH THAT WOULD BE GIVEN TO ME BY OUR PEOPLE AND WAS TO SUSTAIN ME FIRST IN THE YEARS OF OPPOSITION AND THEN AS PRIME MINISTER, MR. PRESIDENT, IN THAT SPEECH I SAID THEN THEN IT WAS NO PART OF MY PURPOSE TO PRESIDE OVER THE CONTINUING DECLINE OF BRITAIN; OVER DIMINISHING INTERNATINAL ESTEEN; OVER THE EBB OF, INDEPENDENT SPIRIT.






