FACT SHEET: START NEGOTIATIONS AND TRIDENT

I. INSPECTIONS AND THE UK TRIDENT PROGRAM

- o The US has recently decided to allow sides:
 - -- to demand (without right of refusal) short-notice inspections at any site where illegal ballistic missile activity is suspected, provided that the suspect site is on a previously agreed list; and,
 - -- to request inspections (with right of refusal) at any other facility at which illegal ballistic missile activity is suspected.
- O In this regard, the US position still requires that, since START is strictly bilateral, all Soviet inspections will be on US territory.
- O No inspections will be conducted on British submarines regardless of whether they carry the Trident missile or use US facilities.
